"U.S. Support of Israel", "Israel's Attack on the Dan River", News Articles from the Jerusalem Post, December 1964

Published in December 1964, this document contains two articles from the Jerusalem Post, the first of which addresses the American aid Israel received in its attack on the Suez Canal, and the second discusses the Israeli attack on the Dan River area in Jordan as its future is dependant on water supplies.

Addressing the Academy of Economics, the former Socialist Premier, Mr. Guy Mollet, said "All published accounts of the Suez Affair are erroneous or untruthful, but I will write nothing about it while Israel's situation remains dramatic. We saved a nation fighting for its existence. I am sorry we did not carry through to the end. It is true Eden yielded and folded up under American pressure. But to reveal the circumstances in which this happened would harm Israel, which remains in danger. If Israel were to be attacked tomorrow it would be very seriously endangered if it counted on American aid.

Speaking at a luncheon given for him by the political reporters in Jerusalem yesterday, Labour Minister Yigal Allon said that the aim of the Syrian attack in the Kibbutz Dan area was to undermine Israeli rights to full use of the sources of the Dan River.

Mr. Allon declared that Israel's future existence depends upon water, and that Israel would view any attempt by the Arabs to divert from her the waters of the Banias and Hasbani Rivers, as an attack on Israel territory.
