

Dear Mr. Koussa:

We noted with interest your comments on a published letter of December 23 from Israel Embassy Officer Hugh Orgel. Understandably, his remarks may be interpreted as Zionist propaganda by the anti-Zionists. However, his letter was intended to qualify the implication in the December 26 TIME story that Israel had done nothing for the Arab refugees. While conceding a point here, we nevertheless are aware that Israel's efforts have not been aimed directly at the heart of the Arab refugee problem.
