Israel and the Arabs

TO THE CHRISTIAN SCIENCE MONITOR:

In your June 9 issue you printed a letter from a resident of California who originally came from what is now Israel.

In that letter, the writer alleged that he, and a great many other Arabs, firmly believed that Britain had deliberately created the state of Israel to hold as a club over the heads of the Arabs.

When one examines the attitude of the British toward the establishment of Israel, beginning with the Balfour Declaration (the one favorable piece of diplomacy extended to the Jews over more than a decade of earnest and almost hopeless labor) to the White Paper, which closed the doors of Palestine to the Jews when their situation in Europe was hopeless, to the machinations of the late Ernest Bevin, and to many other Britons, then in the driver's seat, who blocked all legislation for Israel, one wonders exactly where your letter-writer procured his information.

If he deplores the establishment of Israel in the light that he was forced from his home (only by the decree of the Arab
