Dear Mr. Nusseibeh;

I read with great interest your interview published in the Jerusalem Post of March 28. Permit me to refer to refer to one of the important subjects you are commenting upon: the involvement of the Mufti of Jerusalem with Nazi Germany. The evidence of his collaboration and incitement in the files of the Allied Powers and the U.N. War Crimes Commission is abundant. The enclosed copy of the record of his conversation with Hitler on November 30, 1941 is just one sample from this collection of incriminating documents.

When we met some time ago at the University of Tel Aviv we thought it would be good to get together for a talk. My wife and I would be very pleased to greet you at our home. Should this be inconvenient for you I would gladly come to see you.
